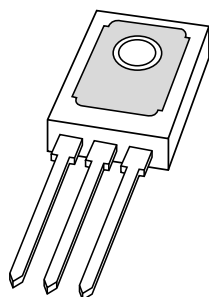

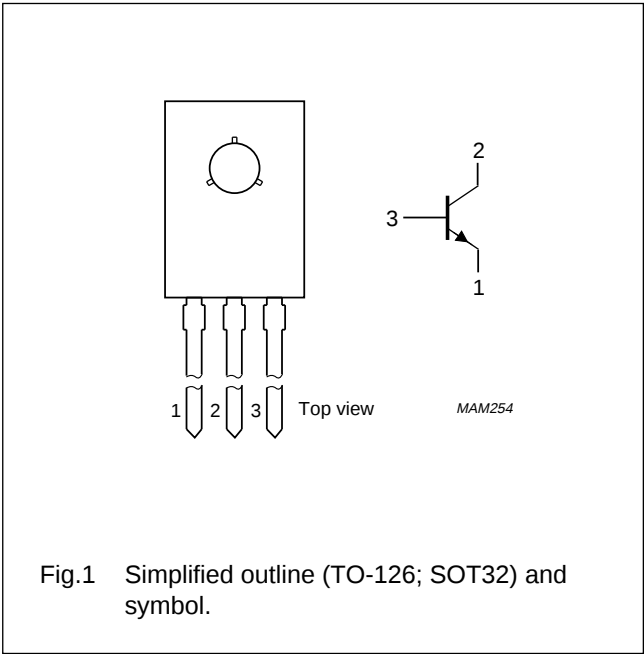


Fig.1 Simplified outline (TO-126; SOT32) and symbol.

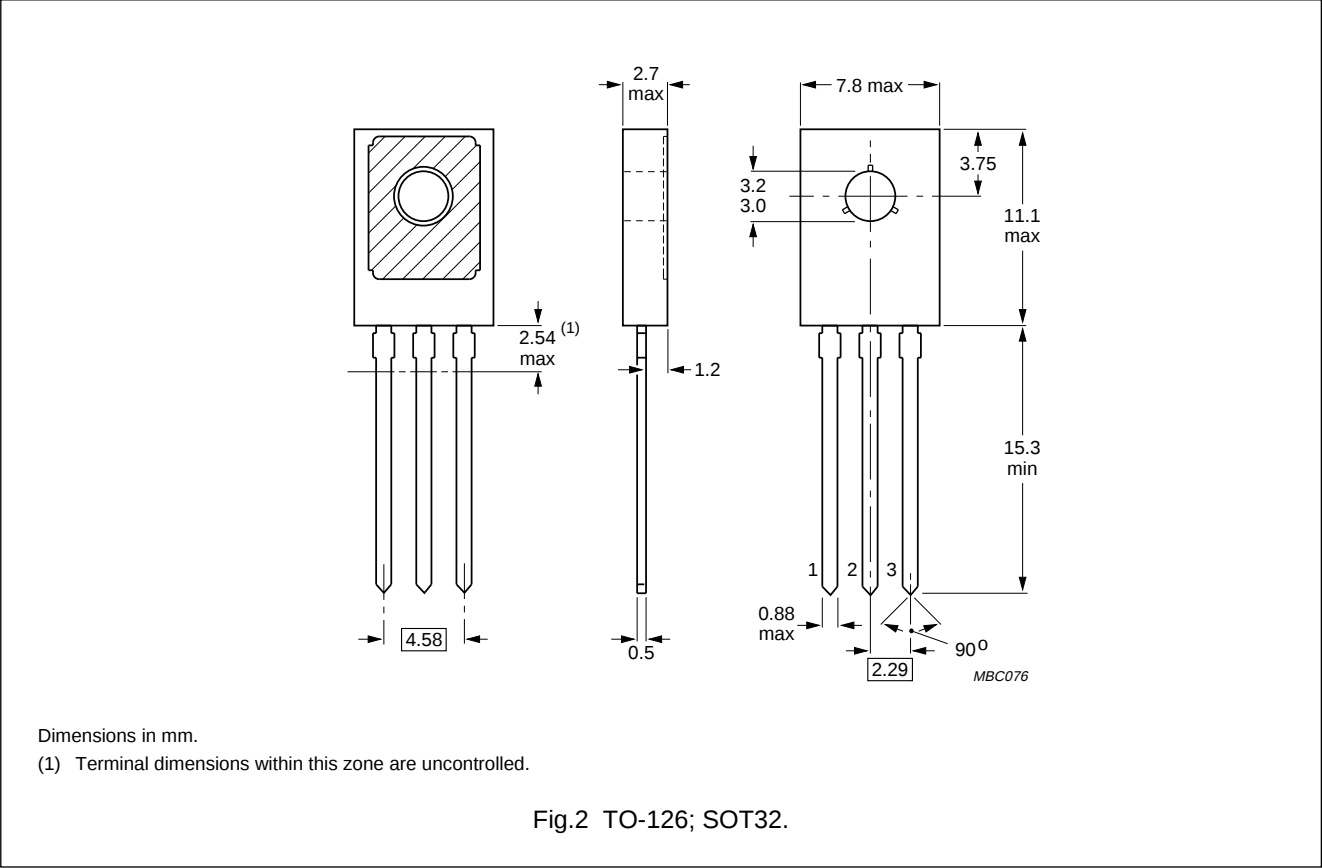
