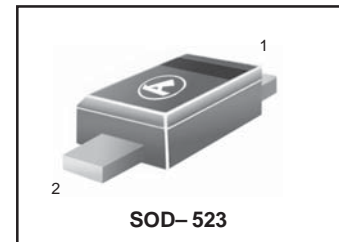


# Variable Capacitance Diode for UFH/VHF Tuner

## HVC202A

### FEATURES

- Low series resistance and good C-V linearity.
- Ultra small Flat Package (UFP) is suitable for surface mount design.

HVC202A = Q

Note: \*1. C.C system (Continuous Connected taping system) enable to make any 10 pcs of ΔC/C continuous in a reel , expect extension to another group.

Calculate Matching Error,

$$\Delta C/C = \frac{(C_{\max} - C_{\min})}{C_{\min}} \times 100 (\%)$$

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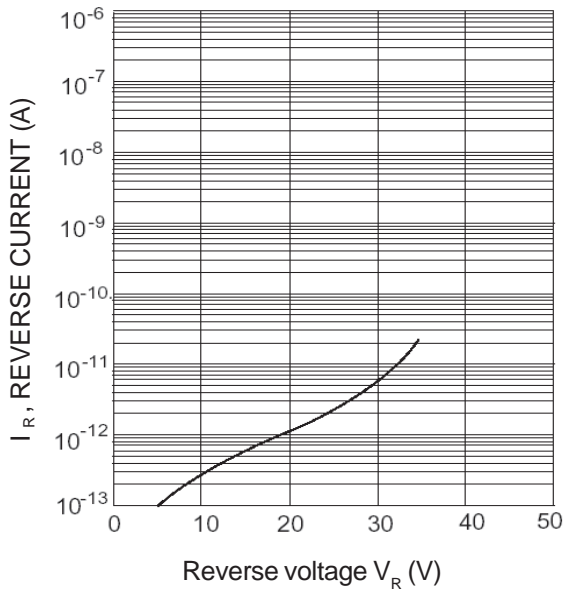


Fig.1 Reverse current Vs. Reverse voltage

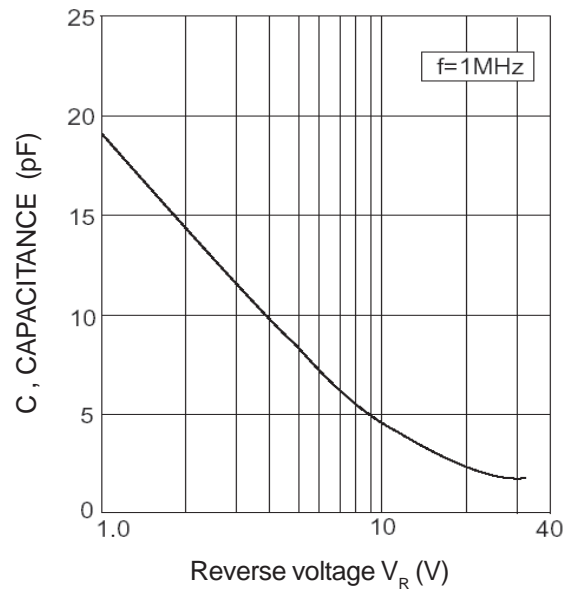


Fig.2 Capacitance Vs. Reverse voltage

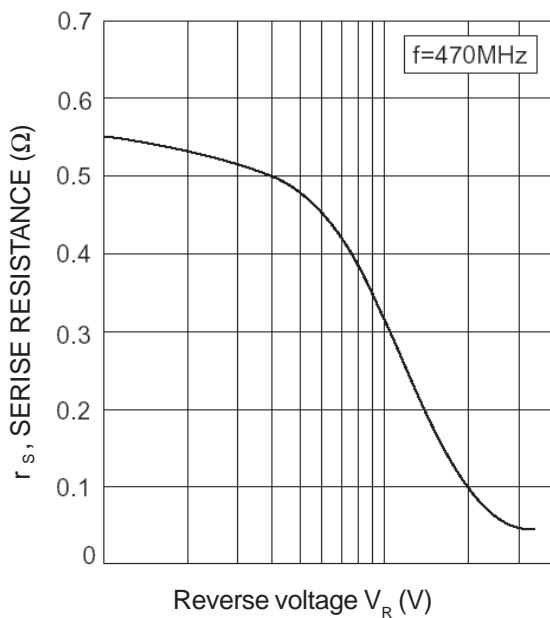


Fig.3 Series resistance Vs. Reverse voltage

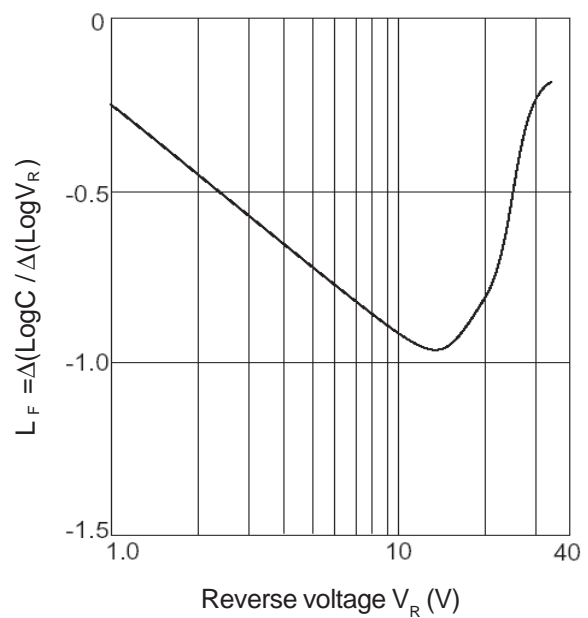


Fig.4 Linearity factor Vs. Reverse voltage
