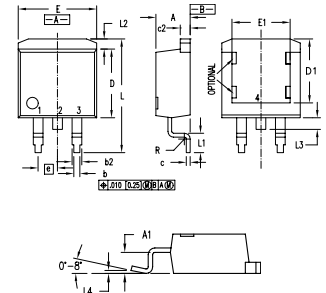

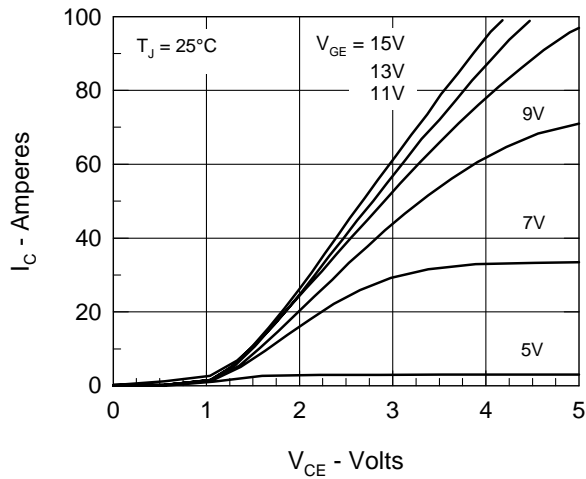


Fig. 1. Output Characteristics

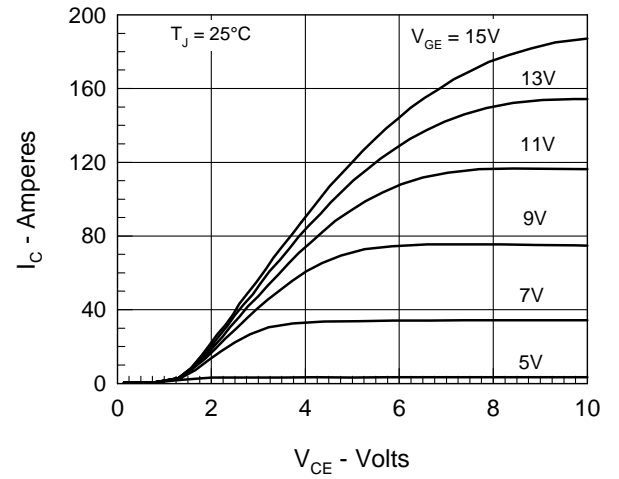


Fig. 2. Extended Output Characteristics

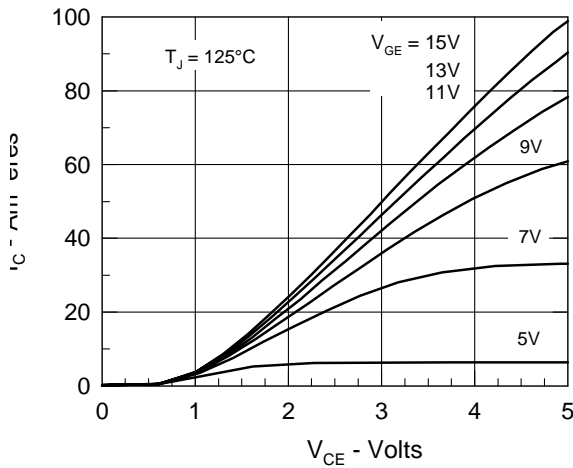


Fig. 3. High Temperature Output Characteristics

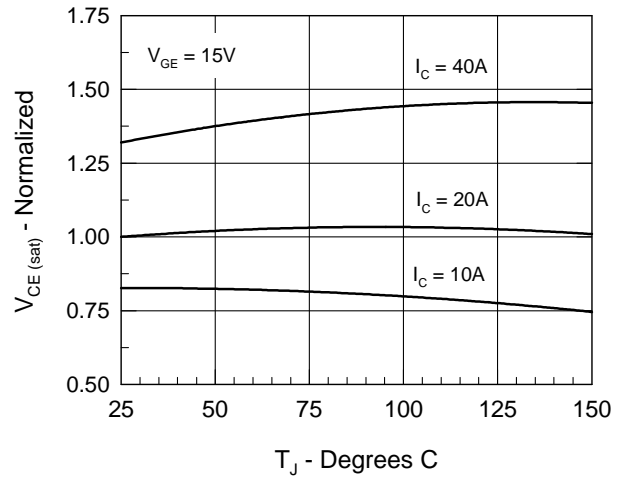


Fig. 4. Temperature Dependence of $V_{CE(sat)}$

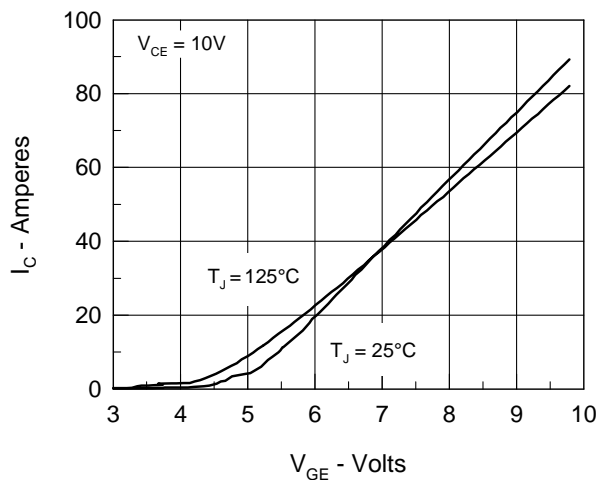


Fig. 5. Admittance Curves

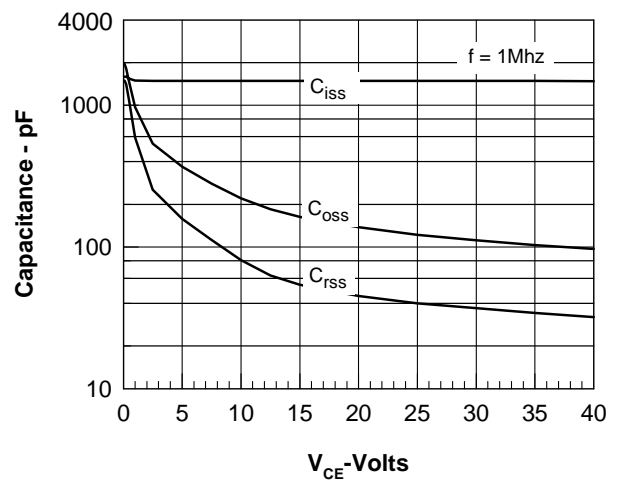


Fig. 6. Capacitance Curves

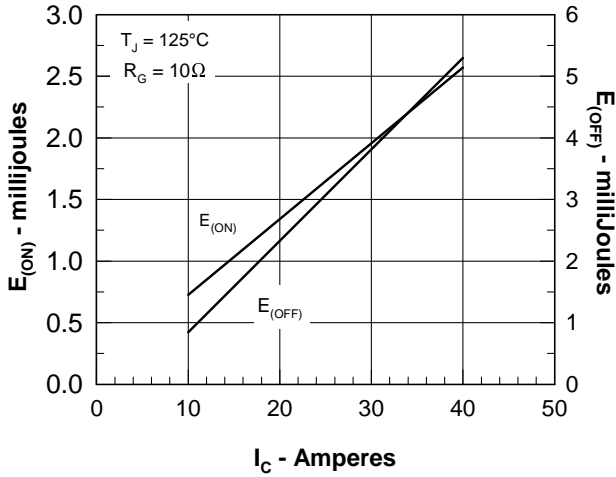


Fig. 7. Dependence of E_{ON} and E_{OFF} on I_C .

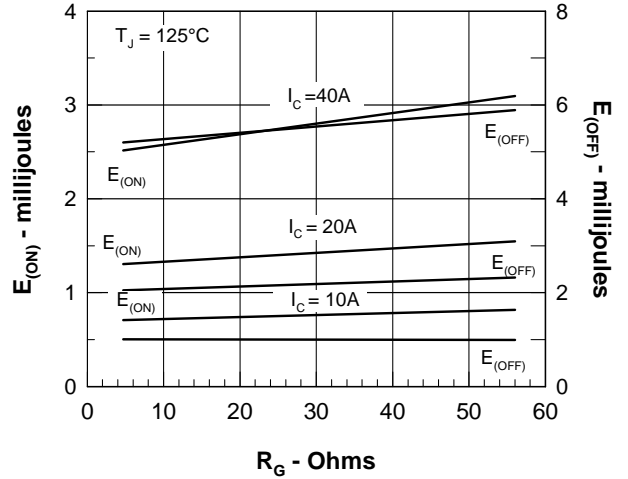


Fig. 8. Dependence of E_{ON} and E_{OFF} on R_G .

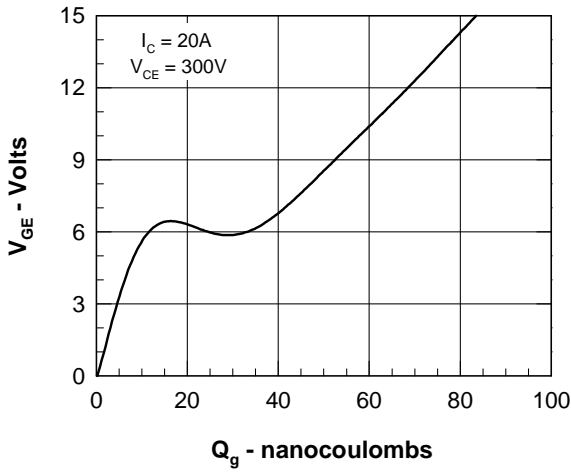


Fig. 9. Gate Charge

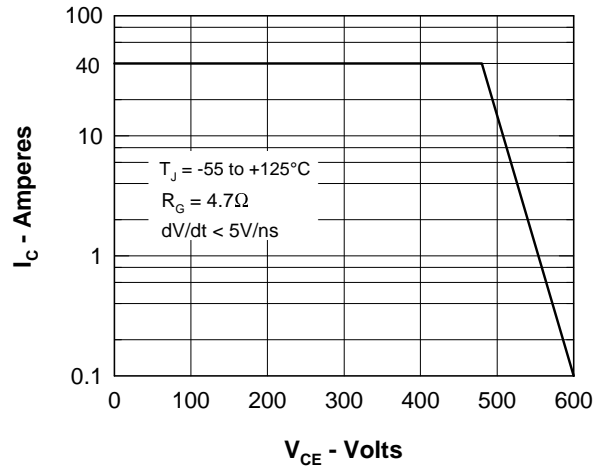


Fig. 10. Turn-off Safe Operating Area

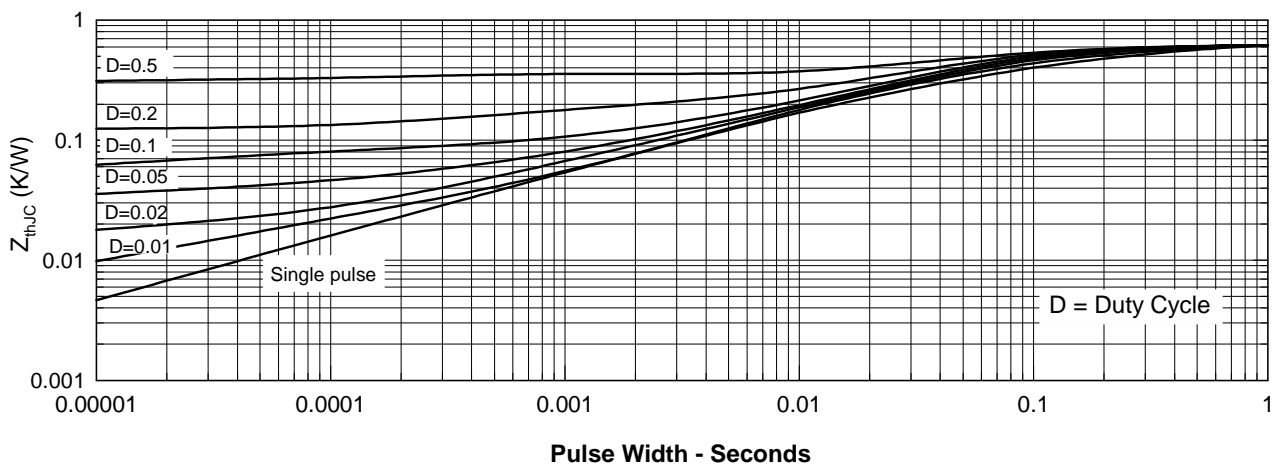


Fig. 11. IGBT Transient Thermal Resistance Junction-to-Case
