

FIG.1-FORWARD CURRENT DERATING CURVE




FIG.3-MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT




FIG.5-TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE





FIG.2-TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS
