




FIG. 3 - TYPICAL INSTANTANEOUS FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG




FIG. 5 - REVERSE SWITCHING CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG




FIG. 2 - MAXIMUM NON-REPETITIVE PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT PER LEG




FIG. 4 - TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS PER LEG





FIG. 6 - TYPICAL JUNCTION CAPACITANCE PER LEG



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
