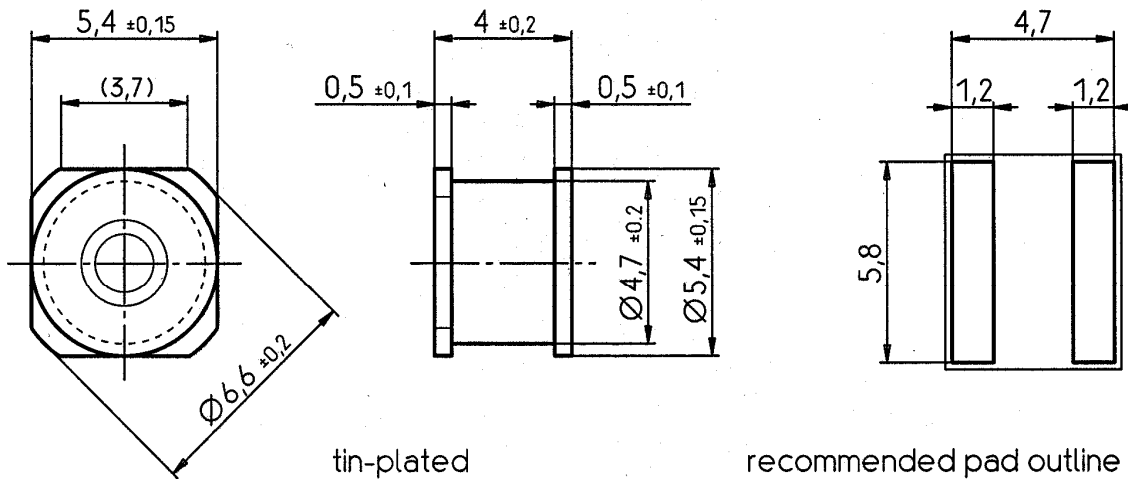

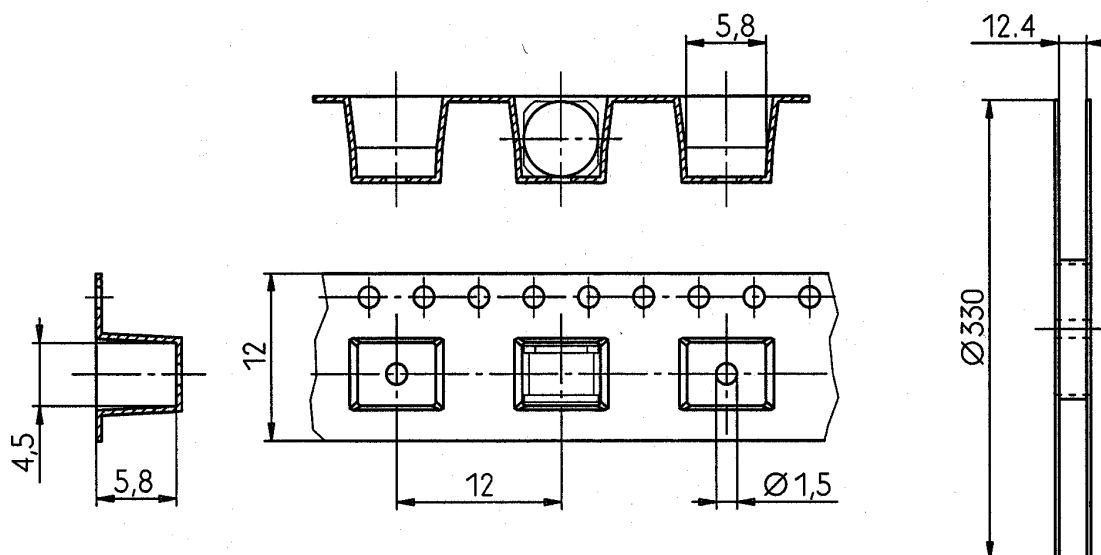

Cautions and warnings

- Surge arresters must not be operated directly in power supply networks.
- If the contacts of the surge arresters are defective, current stress can lead to the formation of sparks and loud noises (bang).
- Surge arresters may become hot in case of longer periods of current stress (danger of burning).
- Surge arresters may be used only within their specified values. In case of overload, the head contacts may fail or the component may be destroyed.
- Damaged surge arresters must not be re-used.
