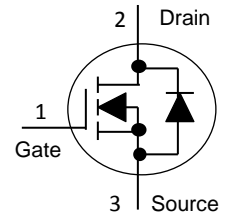
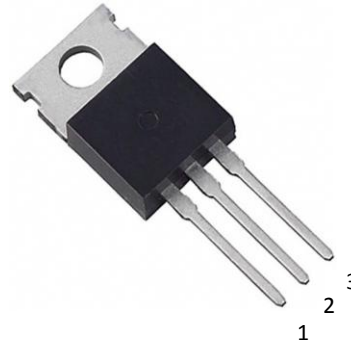

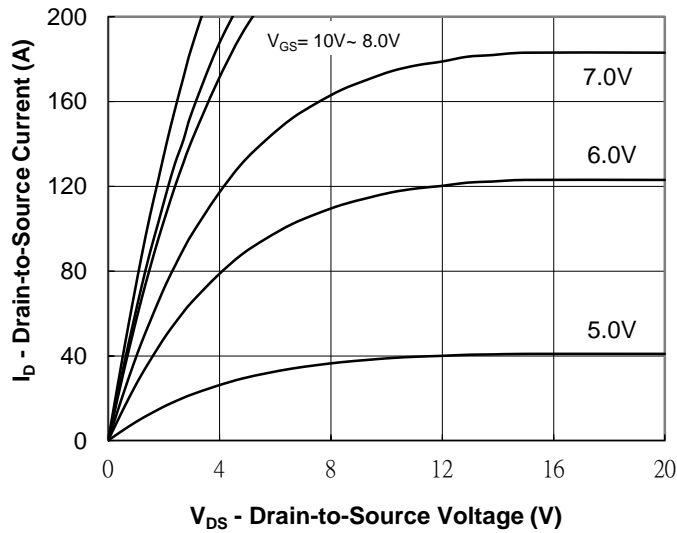


Fig.1 Output Characteristic

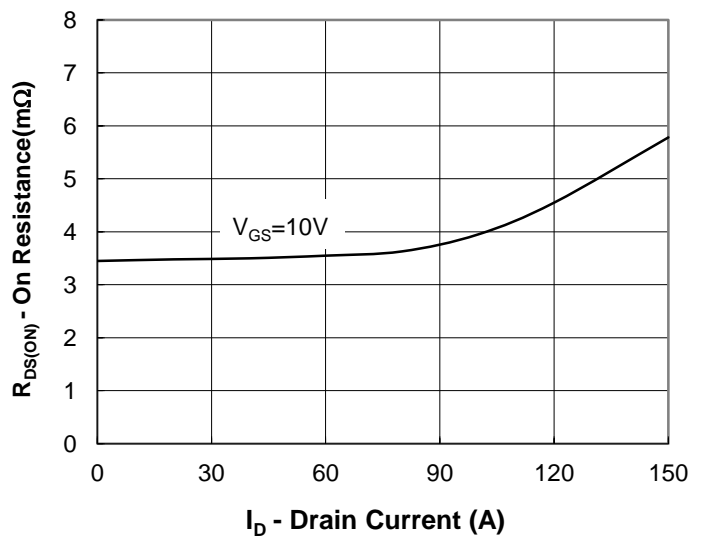


Fig.2 On-Resistance vs Drain Current

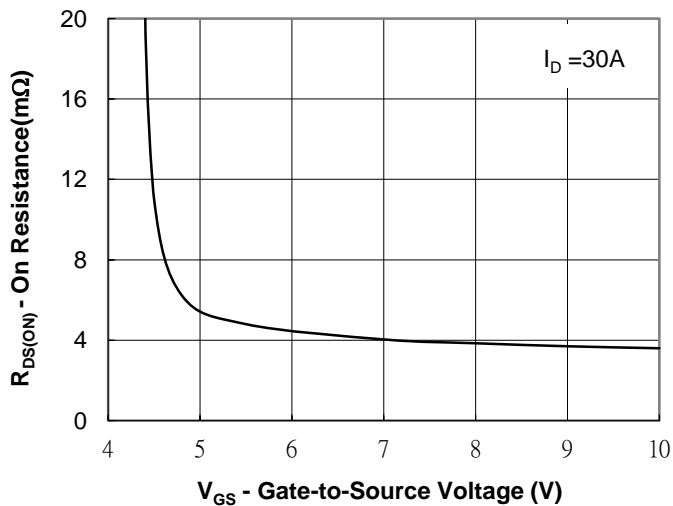


Fig.3 On-Resistance vs Gate to Source Voltage

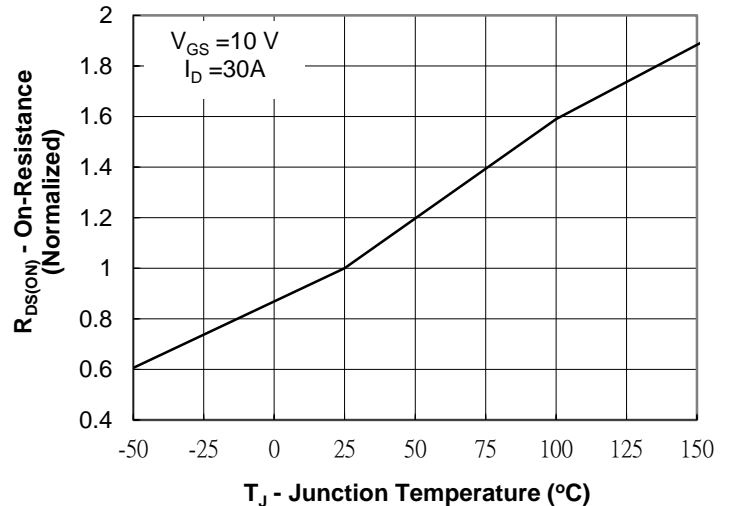


Fig.4 On-Resistance vs Junction Temperature

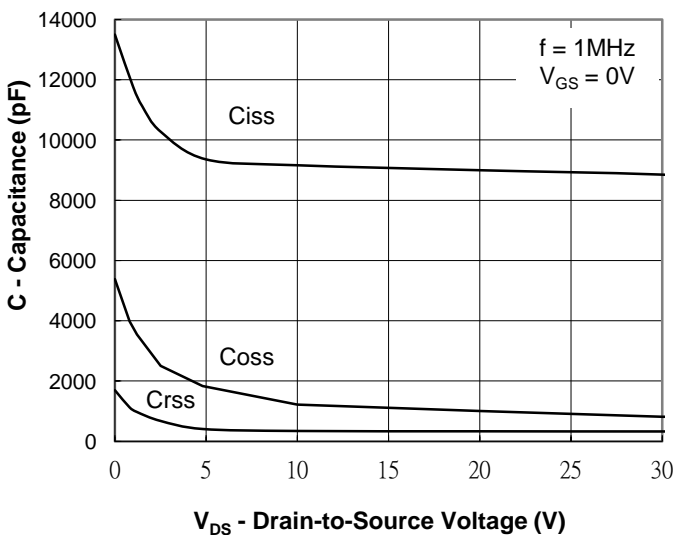


Fig.5 Capacitance Characteristic

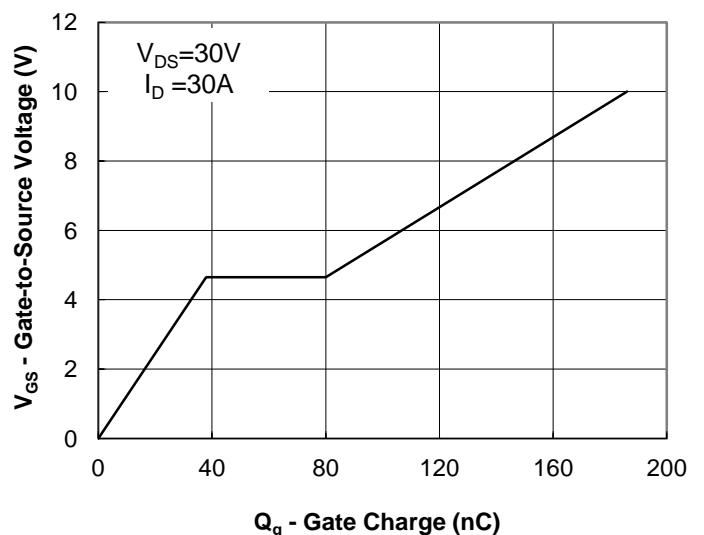


Fig.6 Gate Charge Characteristic

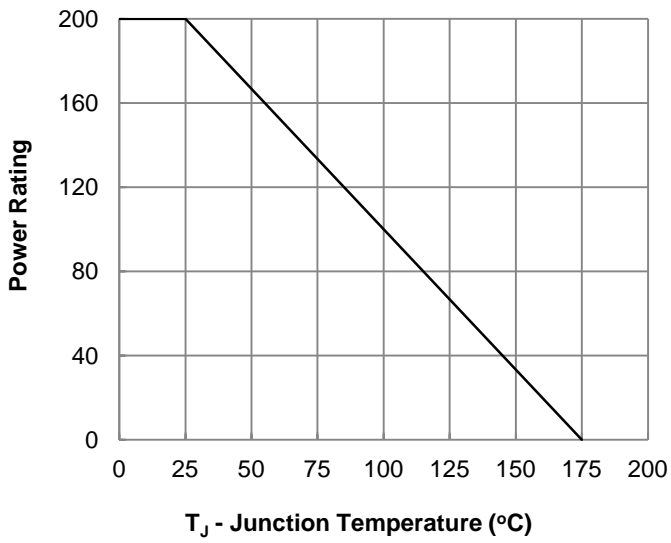


Fig.7 Power Derating Curve

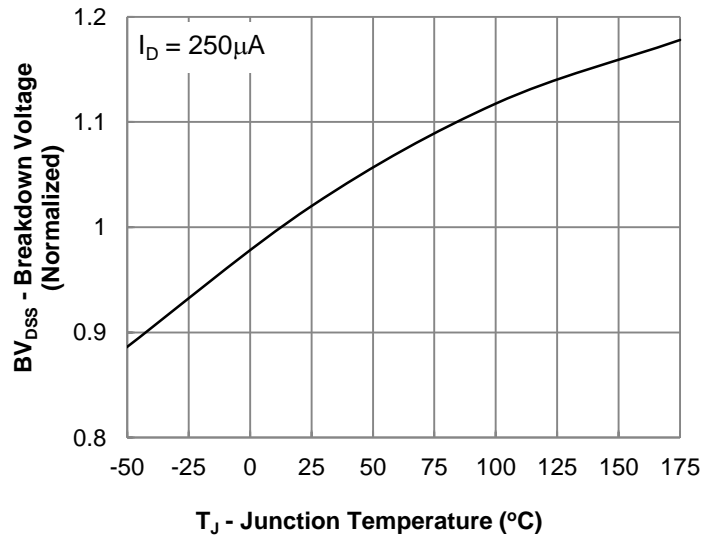


Fig.8 Breakdown Voltage vs Junction Temperature

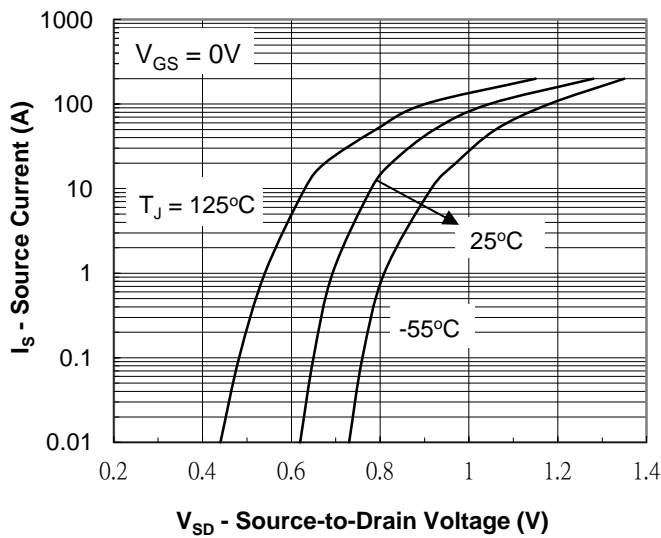


Fig.9 Body Diode Forward Voltage Characteristic
