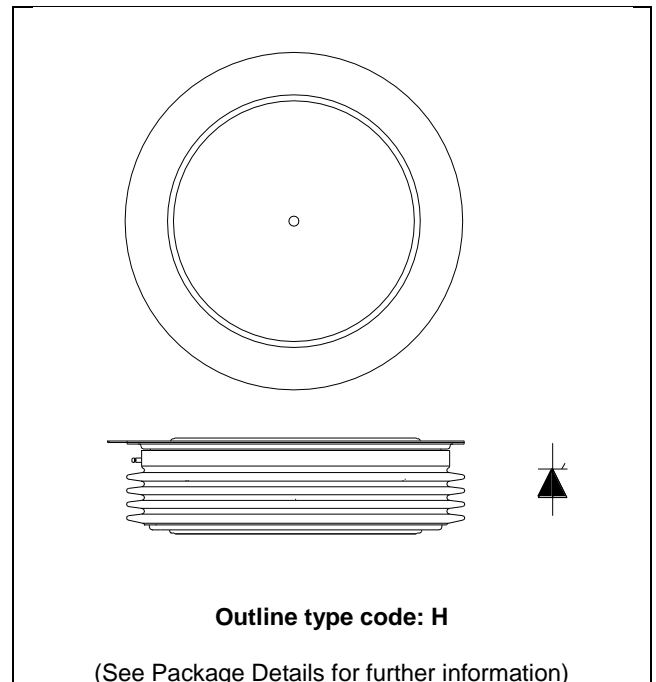


Fig. 1 Package outline

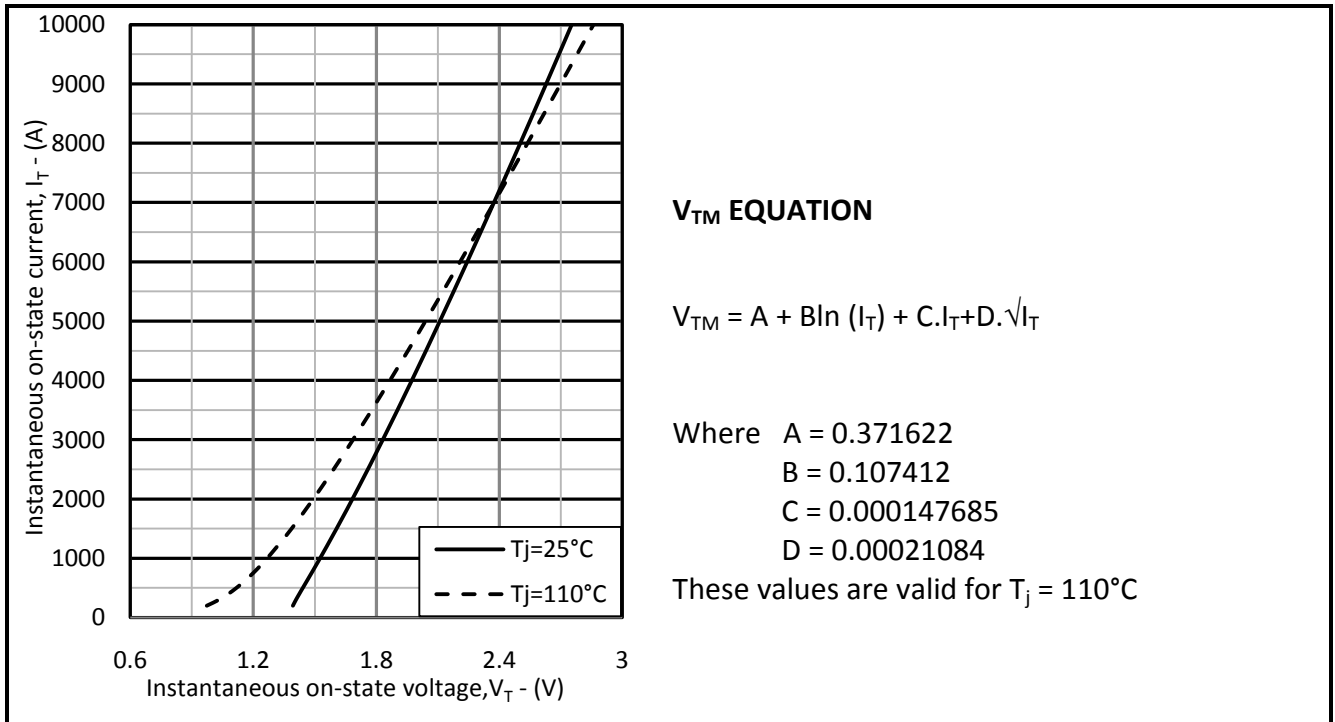

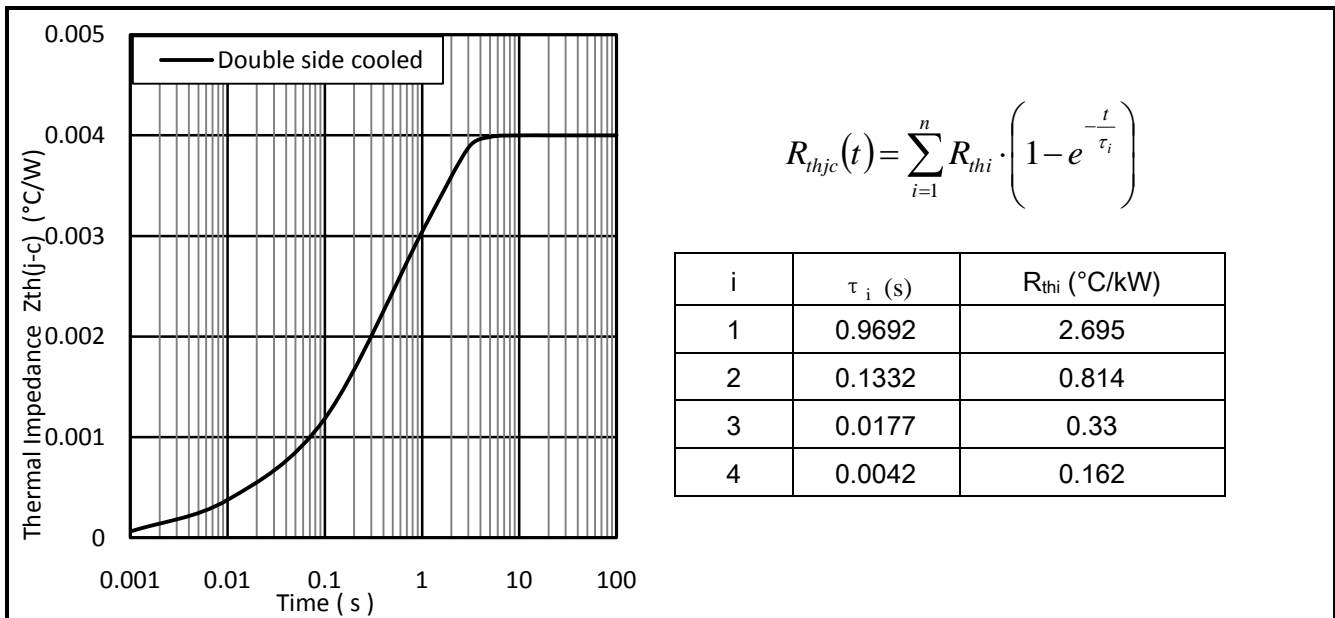

**Fig.3 Maximum (limit) transient thermal impedance – junction to case (°C/W)**

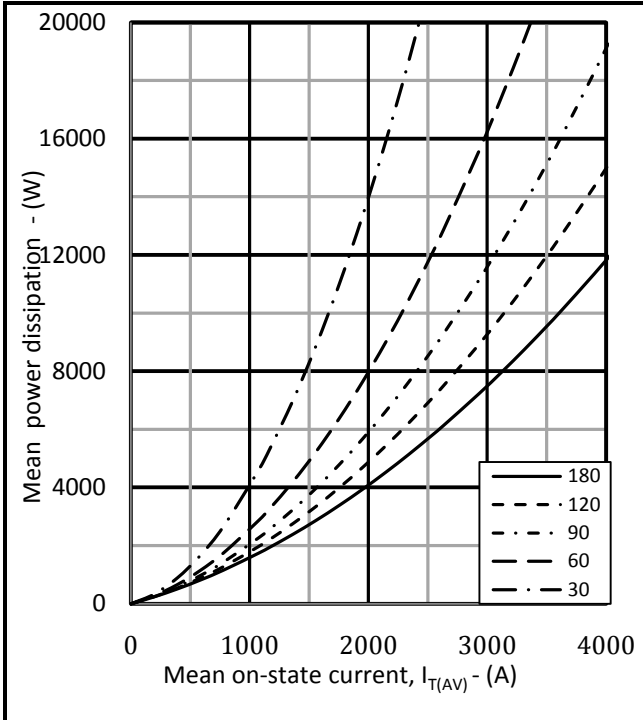


Fig.4 On-state power dissipation – sine wave

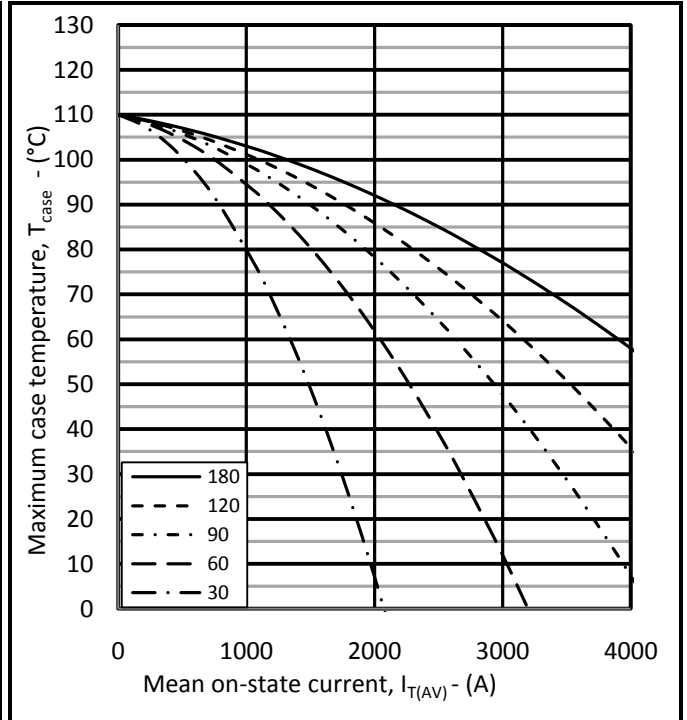


Fig.5 Maximum permissible case temperature, double side cooled – sine wave

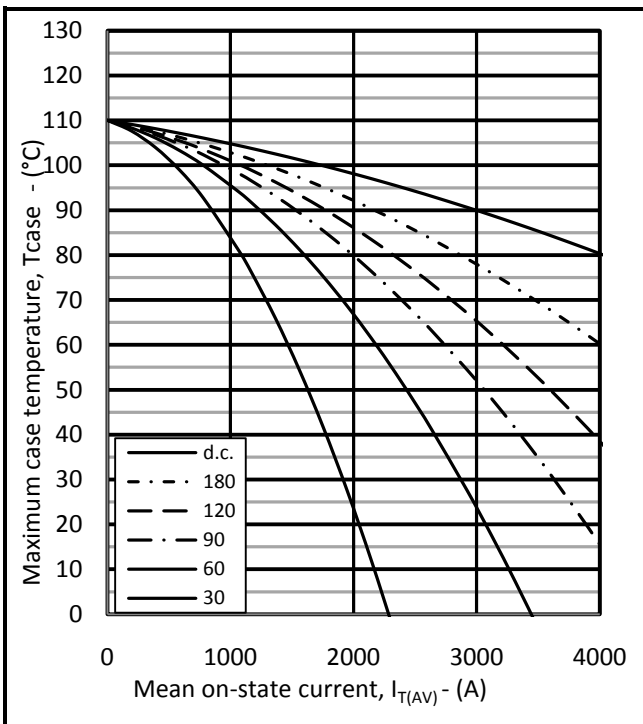


Fig.6 Maximum permissible case temperature, double side cooled – rectangular wave

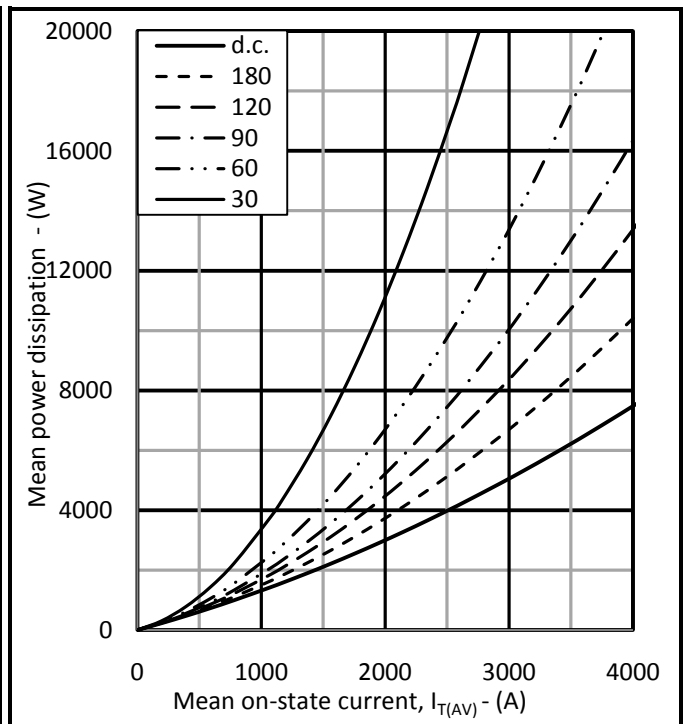


Fig.7 On-state power dissipation – rectangular wave

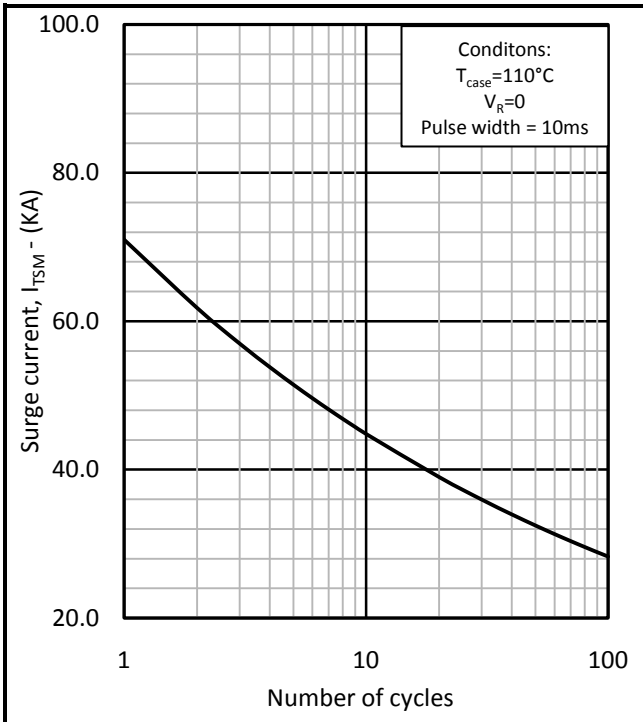


Fig.8 Multi-cycle surge current

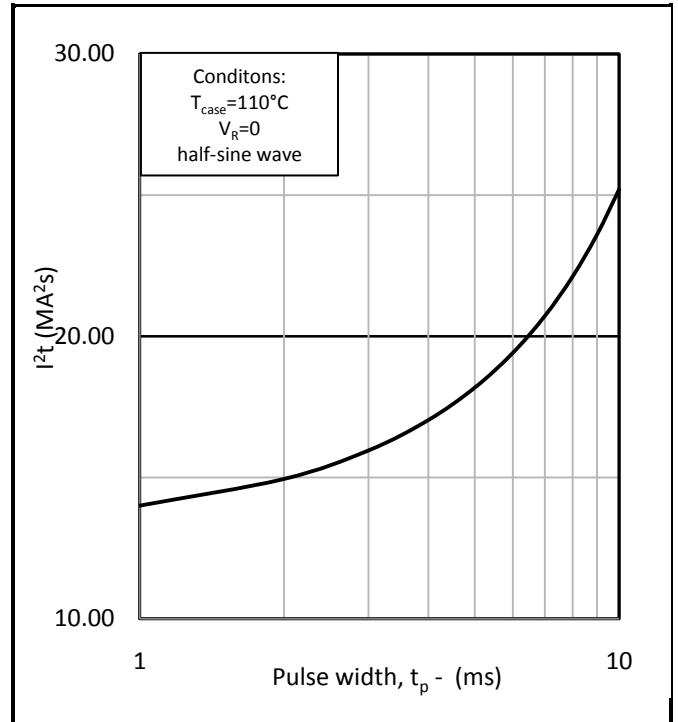


Fig.9 Single-cycle  $I^2t$

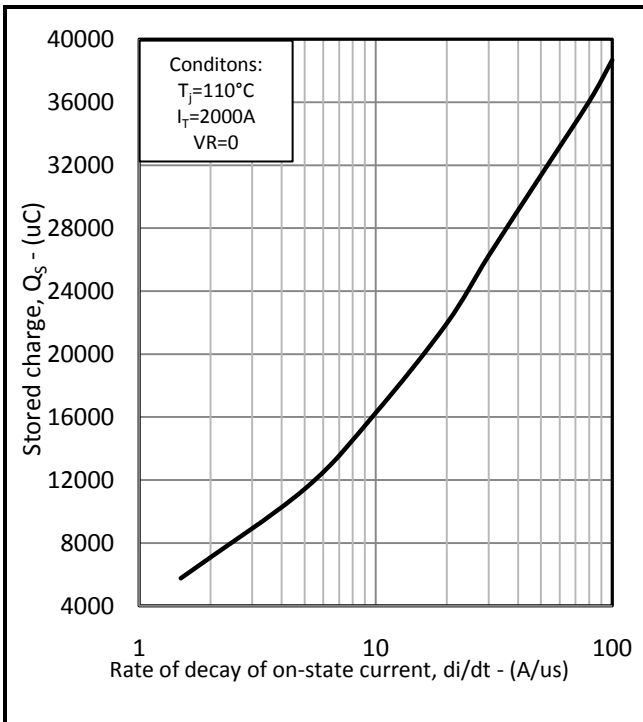


Fig.10 Stored charge vs  $di/dt$

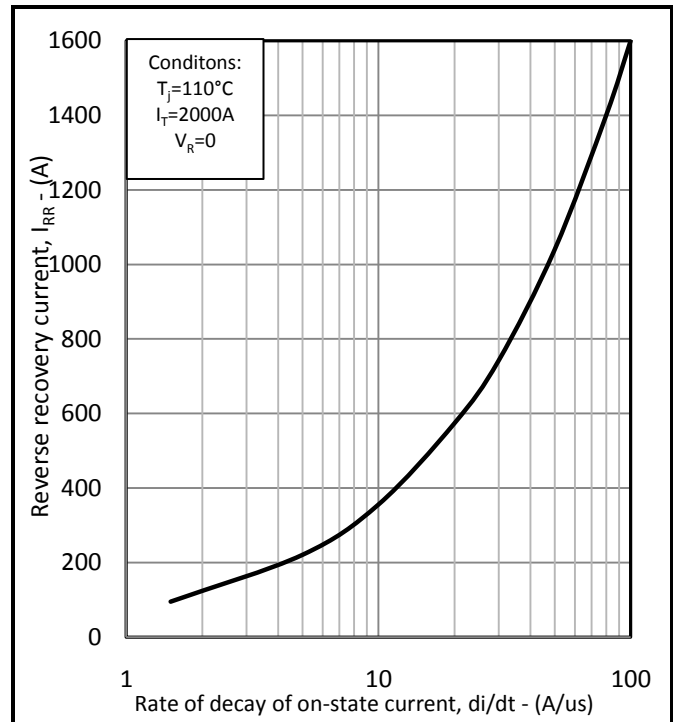


Fig.11 Reverse recovery current vs  $di/dt$

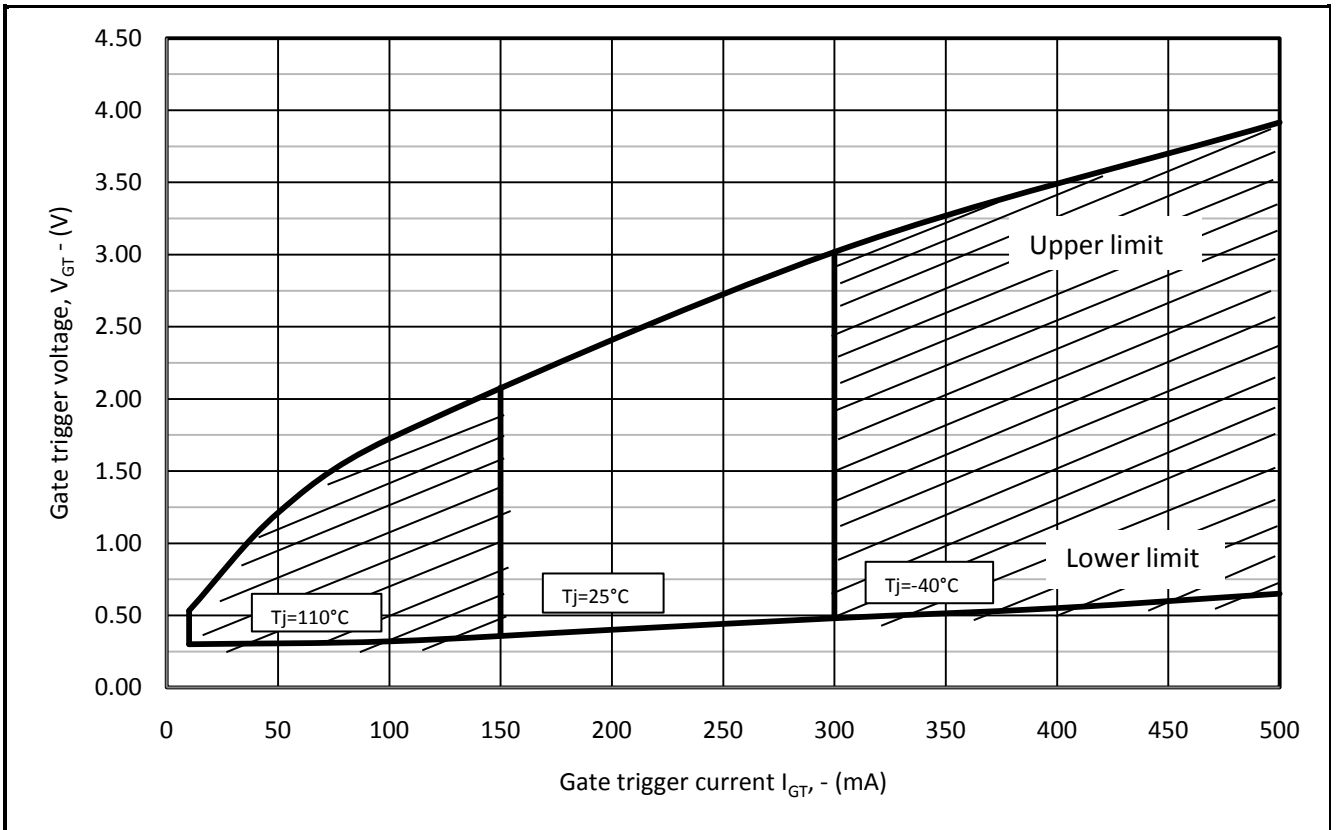
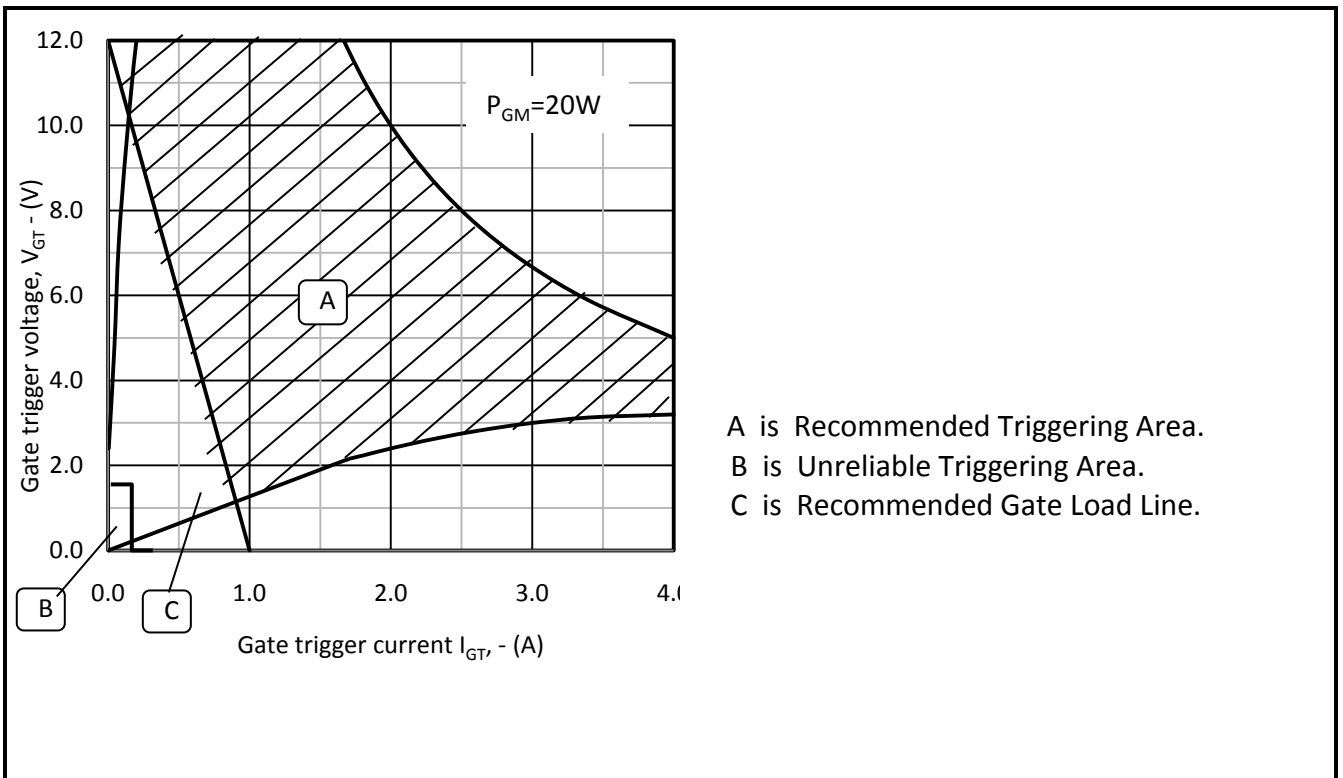


Fig.10 Gate characteristics

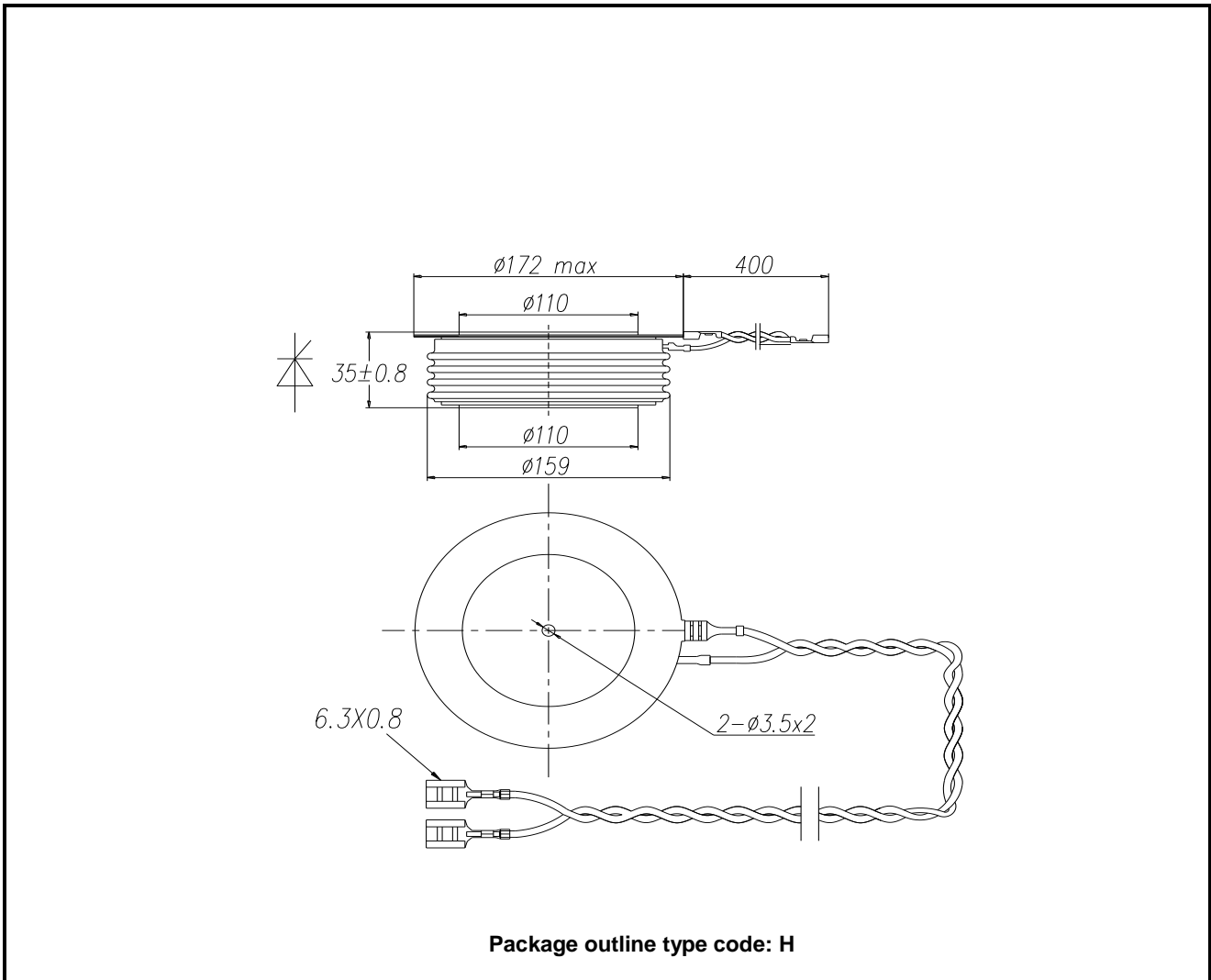


Fig.12 Package outline



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
