The DFM600FXM18-A000 is a dual 1800 volt, fast recovery diode (FRD) module. Designed for low power loss, the module is suitable for a variety of high voltage applications in motor drives and power conversion.

Fast switching times and low reverse recovery losses allow high frequency operation making the device suitable for the latest drive designs employing pwm and high frequency switching.

These modules incorporate electrically isolated base plates and low inductance construction enabling circuit designers to optimise circuit layouts and utilise grounded heat sinks for safety.




Fig. 1 Dual diode circuit diagram




Fig. 2 Electrical connections - (not to scale)







Fig. 2 Diode typical forward characteristics










Fig. 6DC current rating vs case temperature







Fig. 7 RBSOA
