

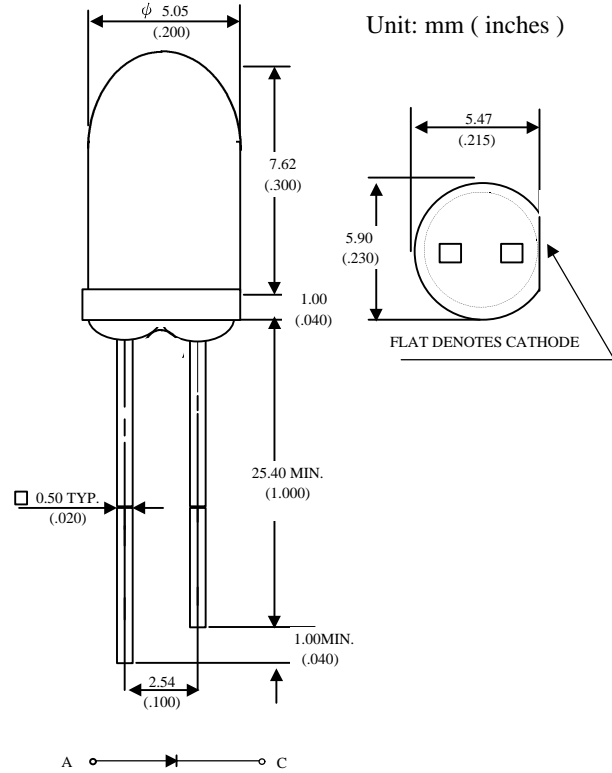

The package is T-1 3/4 ϕ 5mm) water clear plastic type.

Typical Optical-Electrical Characteristic Curves

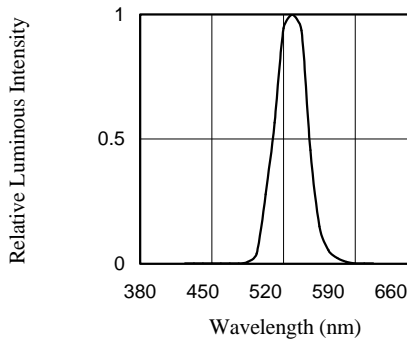


FIG.1 RELATIVE INTENSITY LUMINOUS VS. WAVELENGTH

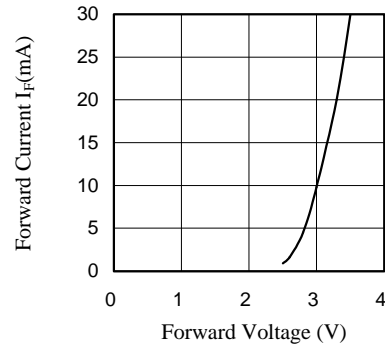


FIG.2 FORWARD CURRENT VS. FORWARD VOLTAGE

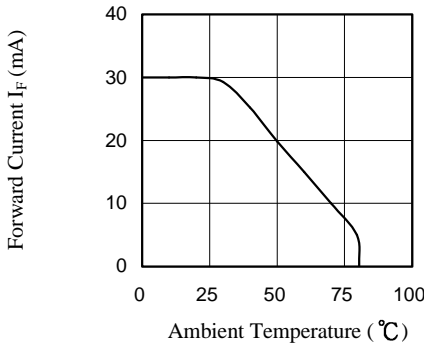


FIG.3 FORWARD CURRENT VS. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

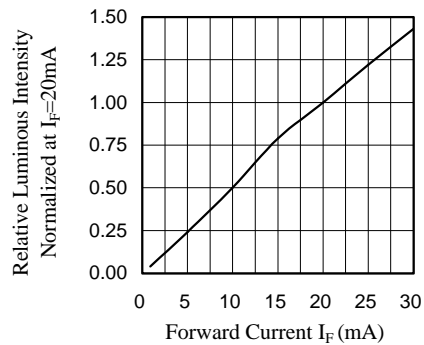


FIG.4 RELATIVE LUMINOUS INTENSITY VS. FORWARD CURRENT

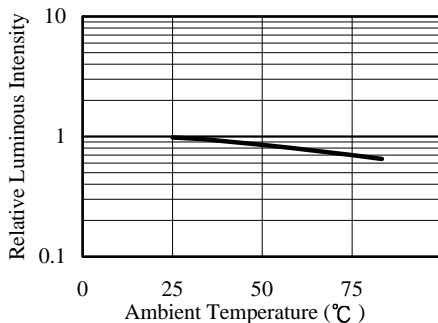


FIG.5 LUMINOUS INTENSITY VS. AMBIENT TEMPERATURE

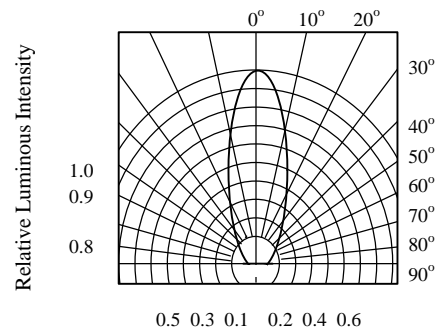


FIG.6 RADIATION DIAGRAM
